Phase I: Discovery & Creative Strategy

To get a project started, we have a discovery call to learn more about your needs and goals. It's important to know what success looks like so we can identify solutions aimed specifically to meet these criteria.

- Develop proposal including preliminary project overview & scope and estimated costs

Phase II: Preliminary Design

After our discovery call, we move into research mode. We'll put together a review of the goals as well as collecting visual cues (mood boards) to explain where we see the project headed. We will develop and present two (2) concepts.

- Develop sketches and concepts
- Solidify concepts for presentation
- Design concept presentation

Phase III: Design Development

Once one final concept is approved, we develop it and hone in on materials, space planning, elevations, etc. so you can see how your project will come to life.

- Review and implement feedback
- Update round 1 designs and present for approval

Phase IV: Prototype Development

We make a small prototype (typically 2' x 2') to show you the design (color, material, layout, attachment).

- Source materials
- Create prototype
- Present prototype
- Review and implement feedback
- Prototype approval

Phase V: Production & Fabrication

The majority of work is completed in our Chicago studio. Throughout the process we will submit timelines, updates and in-progress pictures to keep you informed.

- Site visit + confirm project schedule
- If AllKinds is not doing a site visit the GC or client will need to provide field measurements for us.
- Coordinate with GC + architecture team
- Order all materials and secure vendors
- Fabrication of designed elements
- Provide submittal(s) for client approval

Phase VI: Delivery & Installation

We arrive on site and start installing your new art. This can take anywhere from 1 day with 2 people to many weeks with many people, depending on the scope. Our aim is to create something beautiful on-site, on-time and safely.

DETAILS


We developed the design intent from Media Objectives into a producable piece of art. We studied the cord being connected at the bottom versus floating for a more organic look.

This piece is called 'Glamping' and it is graphic flora created from CNC cut wood frames and paracord to create a vibrant backdrop for this seating area.



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


PING PONG PADDLES

We designed and fabricated a custom magnet detail was made for easy on/off of the paddles behind the acoustical wall covering.







TRIBUNE TOWER X SOHO MYRIAD

DETAILS 3000 hand cut ceramic pieces Custom frame, installed on-site

As part of the Tribune Tower redevelopment project, we created an art piece for the building lobby area. Drawing inspiration from Chicago area wind maps, we hand cut over 3,000 ceramic pieces and laid them out in large wind swoops. This piece is full of delicate detail and brings a lively sense of movement to the space.









CORE PROPERTIES X JOHALLA PROJECTS

DETAILS Hand-painted mural 80' X 17' installation

Core Properties wanted to update this pool area with a hand-painted mural designed to incorporate palms and oranges, that are so iconic to Florida. Something super vibrant for the students to enjoy poolside.






NBC TOWER X PBD ARCHITECTS


DETAILS:

We were asked to create a moment of peace and reprieve hidden in an unused wall in NBC Tower, so we had the idea to create this diorama of a peaceful naturescape. Guests discovered this portal as a moment of surprise in their day.









FULTON LABS X SOHO MYRIAD

DETAILS

- Laser cut brass
- Design, fabrication, install

Soho Myriad commissioned this custom piece for the new Life Sciences lab in Chicago, the first of its kind. Inspired by the DNA helix and the soft curved used throughout the building, we created a beautiful hanging installation made of lasercut brass, two way mirror, and bronze acrylic.

Attention was paid to exterior views and how the light would bounce off the work as the daylight changes throughout the day.





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
DETAILS 30,000 sink cutouts (clients leftover raw materials)

Elkay wanted this 30 foot long lobby and reception area to tell their story. We used the leftover material blanks punched from their sinks during the manufacturing process as the material for this one of a kind ceiling installation.









JONES DAY X SPARK

DETAILS

Inspired by a school of fish, these fish like shapes were water jet cut from aluminum plate and engraved. Each plate is pin mounted to the wall and overall there are 4 heights, so the installation recedes in towards the center.

Signage for their reception desk was included to match.







GOOGLE CLOUD

DETAILS

Thousands of custom cut wood blocks dyed for coloration

For the Google Cloud office in Chicago, we were invited to re-create their gorgeous Cloud logo from scratch. We proposed using simple shapes (circles, squares, triangles...) to create the cloud itself. Each block was hand dyed to be close to the Google colorways, strung with mono filament and placed so that it sits perfect to create the Google Cloud Logo.

This piece is rich with shadow and texture, and brings the logo to life.
